A demonstration of the connections between habitat, wildlife and human activity.

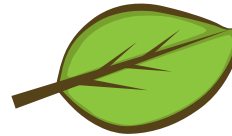


EBB & FLOW

Grades 1 - 9

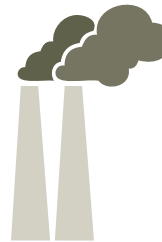
A detailed look at what those 3 Rs really mean, why reduce is the most important, and how folks young and old can make them part of their everyday lives.

TRACE ELEMENTS

HALF DAY \$400
